Please be advised:

Contract Operator would like to remind occupants that due to the desert location of the site, there can be a higher probability of an encounter with rattlesnakes. When you spot a rattlesnake, try to keep track of its location from a safe distance. The Contract Operator quickly responds to remove them when sighted or reported. There is higher than normal snake activity all over, so please be aware of your surroundings.

Watch where you step or reach. Rattlesnakes often hide from the sun when it is hot and are challenging to see.

1. As the temperature cools, rattlesnakes will be seeking concrete/asphalt surfaces in later hours to retain heat, such as sidewalks, parking lots, and roads.
2. **Leave Them Alone** and call the Contract Operator Site Manager at 520-799-7834 or Site Security at 520-799-6666.

First Aid Tips:

1. Indications for anti-venom treatment are based on the injury, not the rattlesnake species.
2. **Do NOT** ice, apply restrictive dressings/tourniquets, or other first-aid measures.
3. **Do NOT** delay care and contact emergency help immediately.
4. **Do** remove constrictive items like shoes and jewelry at the injury.
